Tell me about... apprenticeships

Apprenticeships can help you future-proof your business against skills shortages and other business disruptions. They provide a structured learning programme that ensures your people can meet the needs of your business and industry.

What are apprenticeships?

Apprenticeships are structured training programmes, typically taking three to four years, which result in level 4 trade qualifications for your employees. Theoretical learning supports on-the-job learning and on-campus courses.

How can Competenz Te Pūkenga help?

We work with more than 3,500 employers and 12,000 learners around New Zealand each year to build skills, careers and businesses.

How do I fund an apprenticeship?

The ways that apprenticeships are funded has changed in 2023. If you are concerned about fees impacting your learner's training, there are still some funding options available.

Fees Free

There are specific eligibility criteria that learners must meet. The Fees Free scheme has been reinstated to support first-time learners with funding up to \$12,000 for two years' training. Please check funding eligibility by using the NSN checker on the Fees Free website <u>here</u>.

Apprenticeship Boost

The Apprenticeship Boost is also still open for applications until 31 December 2023. This wage subsidy of \$500 per month is paid directly to employers of new and currently enrolled first and second-year apprentices. Check the eligibility conditions and how to apply on the WINZ website here.
